Assisted suicide bill ____ We have been sent the following by the Bishops' Conference: The important vote for all MPs on the assisted suicide legislation, known as the Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill, is likely to take place on 25th April. The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their Member of Parliament and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law. It can be accessed here: https://righttolife.org.uk/asvote. Also, to let you know, Right to Life is distributing postcards to parishes for the lay faithful to send to their MPs on this subject. Your weekly collection envelopes: Gift Aid Scheme envelopes (with your names on them) are available at the back of the Church if you are in the scheme: If you are not already part of this scheme to further support our parish, please consider joining. All that is required is that you pay income tax of the amount equivalent to your weekly offering, sign a declaration and use a given box of envelopes for your collection.
